MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

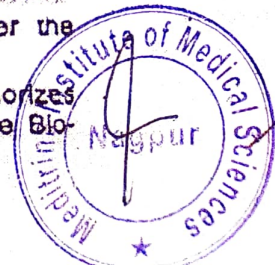
This M.O.U. stands between

- 1) Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur.
- 2) Indian Medical Association, Nagpur.
- 3) Superb Hygienic Disposal, Nagpur.

According to the Notification dated 20th July 2004, the Ministry of Environment and Forest Government of India disposal of biomedical waste is made mandatory. As per the agreement between Party No.1 and Party No.3, Party No.3 is appointed as an agency for collection, transport, storage treatment and disposal of bio-medical waste on build own and operate basis, for the city of Nagpur. In so far as Bio-Medical waste generated in hospital / nursing homes / clinical / laboratories / dispensaries / Maternity homes etc. owned and managed by the member of I.M.A. are concerned, I.M.A. is authorizing Party No. 3 agency for collection, transportation, storage, treatment and disposal of the same and accordingly I.M.A. Nagpur is one of the authorizing Party in this M.O.U.

The terms and condition decided are as follows :-

1. That Party No. 3, Superb Hygienic disposal Nagpur has agreed and undertaken to collect receive, store, transport, treat and dispose the bio-medical waste according to the rules laid by MPCB. The said agency should complete all the formal requirements like seek authorization for collection, transportation, storage and disposal of BMW from MPCB and should abide by the rules and regulations laid by CPCB / MPCB from time to time.
2. The contract stands for a period of 30 years from the execution of agreement, between NMC & M/s Superb Hygienic Disposal, Nagpur where in.
3. NMC Nagpur has appointed M/s Superb Hygienic Disposal's as an agency to collect transport treat and dispose bio-medical waste generated in its city limits as per the agreement between Party No.1 and 3 dated 11-08-2004.
4. Indian Medical Association Nagpur has unanimously agreed and accordingly authorizes M/s Superb Hygienic Disposal as an agency to collect, transport treat and dispose Bio-medical waste generated in hospitals, clinics etc. of its members.

Charges for collection, transportation, storage treatment and disposal of Bio-Medical waste to be carried out by Party No. 3 are agreed to be as under:

Party No. 3 has agreed to collect the Bio-Medical waste from individual nursing home / hospital / dispensary / clinic / maternity home / laboratory / blood bank etc. and I.M.A. as such is not involved in the process of collection to disposal of Bio-Medical waste. The charges as agreed will be paid by individual member and shall be collected from individual member by Party No. 3.

6. NMC has agreed to provide required land for the project on lease basis and also provide all necessary NOC for official requirement.

After examining the proposal, The Maharashtra Pollution Control Board hereby Renew Combined Consent and BMW Authorization to HCE under Section 25/26 of the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Section 21 of the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, and Authorization under Rule 5 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 respectively, Under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, subject to terms and conditions as specified below and in the **Schedules(I-IV) and Annexures (I-II)** enclosed in this order.

1. The renewal of conditional Combined Consent to Operate and Biomedical Waste Authorization is granted from **30-12-2019 To 30-12-2022**
2. The capital investment of the HCF is **₹4256.00** Lakhs (As per C.A Certificate submitted by HCF)
3. HCF Area: - Plot Area 890.01 M² with Built-up area 3044.04 M².



4. Activities Included

A. Total Number of Beds : **100 Nos** (As per BNH certificate no. 895 valid upto 31-03-2023)

1. General Beds : **100 Nos**

5. Conditions under the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974:-

1. Quantity of total water consumption shall not exceed 35.00 M³/day. You shall not use the ground water without obtaining prior permission of Central Ground Water Authority.
2. You shall provide adequate treatment & disposal facility for sewage & Effluent generated as specified in **Annexure-I**
3. You shall provide water meter at water intake point & at sewage/Effluent disposal point and shall maintain monthly records thereof.

6. Conditions under the Air (P&CP) Act, 1981:-

1. You shall use the fuel for DG set and Boiler(s) as specified in the **Annexure-II**.
2. You shall provide adequate emission control system to DG set and Boiler(s) as specified in **Annexure-II**.
3. You shall strictly observe noise standards applicable for DG set stack emission and ambient noise level as per **Annexure-II**.


7. Conditions under Hazardous Waste (M & TM) Rules 2016:-

You shall have valid membership of CHWTSDF and shall dispose the Hazardous waste generated i.e. ETP sludge in strict compliance with said rules and maintain record thereof.

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4. **Mercury Waste:** You shall manage the Mercury Waste in HCE in environmentally sound manner (including storage, spilled collection, transportation and disposal) as per guidelines published by CPCB as detailed in document entitled "Environmentally Sound Management of Mercury Waste in Health Care Facilities" (www.cpcb.nic.in).
10. You shall not undertake Modifications/ Upgradation in existing facility without obtaining prior Environment Clearance under the Provision of EIA notification, 2006 Or Consent to Establish from the MPC Board as applicable.
11. Any unauthorized change in Location, Name, personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by you shall constitute a breach of this CCA. In case of any change you shall apply fresh for CCA or amendment as applicable.
12. You shall not Rent, Lend, Sell, Transfer or Close Down the facility or otherwise transport / Handover the Bio-Medical waste generated for any other purpose without obtaining prior written permission of the MPC Board.
13. This Board reserves the right to review, amend, suspend, revoke, or change any of the conditions applicable under this CCA and the same shall be binding on the HCE.
14. You shall maintain records of MPC board Officers visit and shall obey all the lawful instructions issued by the Board Officers from time to time.
15. Any violation of provisions of BMW Management Rules, 2016 as amended shall attract the penal provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Violations under the provisions of Water (P&CP) Act 1974, Air (P&CP) act 1981 shall attract provisions of respective act including closure of the facility and prosecution.
16. This CCA shall not be construed as exemption from obtaining necessary NOC/permission from any other Government agencies as applicable.
17. As per the JVS dated 02.03.2019, BOD parameter found exceeds the CCA limit; hence, 25 % Bank Guarantee for Operation and Maintenance of combined wastewater treatment plant to achieve prescribed discharged standards is eligible to forfeit & shall submit double Bank Guarantee.
18. You shall obtain NOC of CGWA, Nagpur, in case of using extracted ground water for Hospital.
19. You shall submit separate online consent application for Oxygen Generation Plants operating by you for hospital.
20. You shall submit the Bank Guarantee of Rs. 2,87,500 /- towards compliance of conditions as specified in Schedule III to Regional Officer, MPCB, Nagpur within 15 days.
